

Igloos





Igloos are snowhouses. Until the second half of the 20th century, many Inuit people in northern Canada ⁽¹⁾ ______ (live) in igloos. Nowadays, these people usually live in modern houses, and igloos (2) (use) mainly by hunters. For a skilled Inuit person, building an igloo is quite easy and (3) (not take) long. First, snow ⁽⁴⁾ (cut) into blocks with a large knife. Then, the blocks ⁽⁵⁾ (place) on top of each other to make the dome-shaped igloo, as shown in the pictures.
