

## **Methods of Communication in Spain**

(% of people who use four different methods one or more times per week)



The chart shows two important trends in the ways people communicate with others. First, the use of landline phones and letters is decreasing. In 1998, landline phone and letter were the <sup>(1)</sup>\_\_\_\_\_common methods of communication. However, <sup>(2)</sup>\_\_\_\_\_people use these methods now, and projections for 2028 suggest that both methods will be <sup>(3)</sup>\_\_\_\_popular in the future.

The chart also shows a dramatic increase in the use of mobile phones and email.
